

## Participation „Second World Landslide Forum“, Rome 3rd-9th October 2011

The second World Landslide Forum (<http://www.wlf2.org>) is held in order to provide a global cross-cutting information and cooperation platform for all types of organizations representing academia, United Nations organisations, governments, private enterprises and individuals that contribute to landslide research, practice, education and decision making and are willing to strengthen landslide and other related Earth system risk reduction strategies.

The goals and achievements of the Monitor II projects fit to the objective of the forum and some partners presented posters and oral presentations during this event.

In particular PP7 and PP5 showed some practical applications developed in the frame of the Monitor II project in their testbeds as they are both dealing with large landslides. PP7 provided furthermore a general overview of the goals and topics touched by the project presenting the poster “Improve Information provision for disaster management: Monitor II, EU project”. During the poster presentation the WP3 brochure – new methods for linking hazard mapping and contingency planning and the project folder were handed out to all interested people.

The three papers will be published in volumes edited by Springer-Verlag and will be available as of early spring 2012.

The Forum was held in Rome at the FAO headquarter and organized by the by the Global Promotion Committee of the International Programme on Landslides (IPL).
